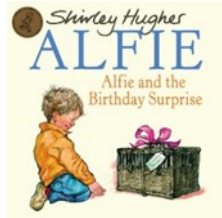


Literacy

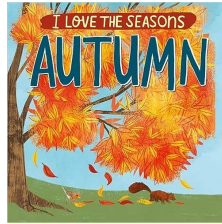
Key texts we will read:

Speech & Language:

As communicators we will:

- Practice turn taking games, to develop our conversational skills
- Learn new songs, to learn new vocabulary
- Practice communicating with our peers on a 1:1 basis in games and within the explore areas.

Maths

As mathematicians we will:

- Match and sort objects
- Count and explore numbers up to 20
- Represent objects and numbers up to 20
- Recognise numbers as words
- Count on from a number
- Find 1 more and 1 less than a number
- Compare groups by matching
- Order objects and numbers

PE:

As active pupils we will:

- Develop speed over varying distances
- Develop passing skills
- Develop agility and coordination
- Explore moving with the ball
- Develop passing the ball
- Develop passing with accuracy

Art:

As artists we will:

- Create repeating patterns
- Create a collage using a variety of materials
- Recap primary and secondary colours
- Explore mosaic patterns
- Develop techniques to collage 3d sculptures

Music

As musicians we will:

- experience different musical sounds and timbres
- use instruments to explore different musical sounds
- explore a range of musical textures
- create musical textures by layering sound

PSHE:

As caring citizens we will:
