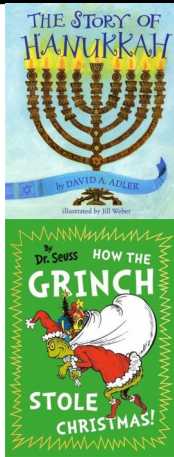


Literacy
