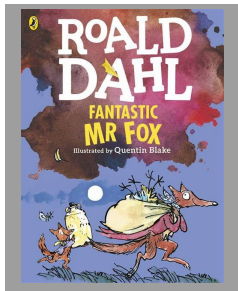


Literacy

- Beverley is a town. Beverley is smaller than a city but larger than a village.
- Hull is a city. Cities are bigger than towns and villages.
