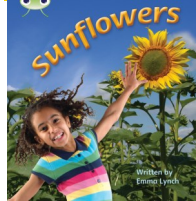
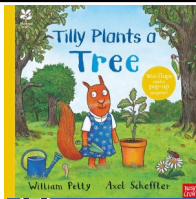


Literacy

Maths

As mathematicians we will:

- build numbers to 20
- count to 20
- add more and take some away
- count in 2s, 5s and 10s
- make arrays
- find a half and a quarter of a shape or number

PE:

As active pupils we will:

- develop our over arm throw
- develop our under arm throw
- to grip the bat correctly
- to develop tracking and defending against an opponent
- to aim accurately at a target

Art:

As artists we will:

- mix tones of the same colour using black and white
- create textured paints
- paint over a collage
- learn about hot and cold colours

- sing songs with a clear verse and chorus

Speech & Language:
