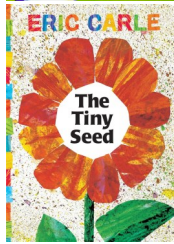
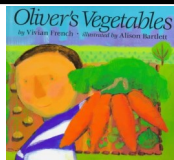


Literacy

- The Tiny Seed

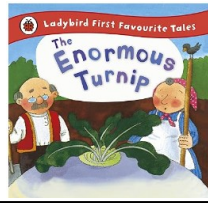


As readers we will:
