

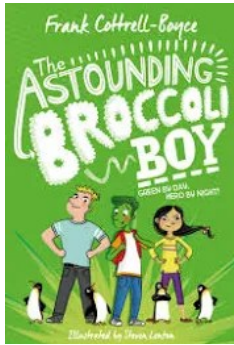
Literacy
