# New knowledge we will acquire:

- The Romans invaded Britain in 43 AD to 420 AD. Julius Caesar attempted invasion in 55BC and failed but Claudius succeeded in 43AD.
- The Romans invaded Britain because Britain had lots of resources, riches and land
- Boudica vas one of the main leaders of the British resistance. Boudica was a Celt.
- Roman soldiers worked together on the battlefield to make the Roman army one of the most feared fighting units in history.
- The Romans brought their ideas of technology, culture and beliefs from Rome.
- The Romans left Britain because the armies were needed to defend other parts of the empire.

# Learning activities we will complete:

- Create a timeline of main events of the Romans in Britain.
- Research and discuss Celts, Boudicca and tribes. Sequence invasion events.
- Learn essential military skills of marching and basic drill, as recruits we will make our own oil lamp and learn about Roman writing. Discover Roman forts and Roman religion.
- Carousel of activities. Discussing and explaining how the Romans impacted Britain and it's influences today.
- Discuss facts about The Romans conquering England and the reason for their fall. Role Play being a Roman Soldier and explain why you left Britain.
